

Terms and Conditions of Lexis+[®] Webinar Prize Draw
(Terms and Conditions)

1. Entry Terms	1.1. Information on how to enter the Lexis+ Webinar Prize Draw (Prize Draw) and prizes form part of these Terms and Conditions. To the extent of any inconsistency between these Terms and Conditions and any other published materials, these Terms and Conditions will prevail. 4. Eligibility	<p>4.1. This Prize Draw is open to New Zealand residents only aged 18 or over who:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) are members of the New Zealand Bar Association; and (b) currently subscribe to the Lexis Advance[®] service either: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) directly (Individual Subscriber); or (ii) via their chambers subscription agreement (Chambers Subscriber); and (c) do not currently subscribe to the Lexis+ service; and (d) attend a Webinar, (Entrants). <p>4.2. The Promoter may accept errors and omissions at its discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights.</p> <p>4.6. If there is a dispute as to an Entrant's identity, the Promoter reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to determine the Entrant's identity.</p>
<p>5. Prize Draw Period</p>	<p>5.1. This Prize Draw commences on 15 May 2024 at 5:00 pm (NZST) (Opening Date) and entries close at 19 June 2024 at 1:00 pm (NZST) (Closing Date) (the period being the Prize Draw Period).</p>

The Promoter will accept only one entry per person. An Entrant is not required to purchase any goods or services from the Promoter to enter and any purchase will not increase an Entrant's chance of winning the Prize.</p> <p>6.3. The Promoter will not consider entries not completed in accordance with these Terms and Conditions or received after the Prize Draw Period has ended. Incomplete or incomprehensible entries will be disregarded. The Promoter accepts no responsibility for late, lost or misdirected entries.</p> <p>6.4. 9. Notification of Winner	<p>9.1. The Winner will be notified in writing to the email address provided in their entry within two (2) working days of the Draw or Redraw (Notification).</p> <p>9.2. 14. Name and Likeness	<p>14.1.
